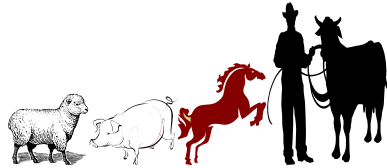


LIVESTOCK DEATHS CAUSED BY A FOREIGN ANIMAL DISEASE

WHY?

- To prevent a secondary disease of botulism.
- To prevent further spread of a disease to other livestock and possibly humans, only if it is Communicable.
