

SEASONAL HERD MANAGEMENT

Livestock Producer Duties and Responsibilities

1. Veterinary care and nutritional support for all livestock and horses
2. Seasonal vaccinations & deworming
3. Record Keeping
4. Management / Husbandry practices
5. Grazing resource management – Balance of resources
6. Reporting of violations / disease suspects
7. Proper disposal of large animal carcasses if an animal dies
8. Isolate new livestock for two weeks before entering herd

Seasonal Livestock Treatments - Fall

<p>(Boost young calves & vaccinate any missed cattle)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blackleg 8-way vaccination • Killed viral respiratory vaccine with H. Somnus & Lepto • Deworm (Internal & External Parasites) • Vitamin A & D 	<p>(Boost young lambs & vaccinate any missed sheep)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Covexin 8 vaccination • Pasteurella vaccination • Deworm (Internal & External Parasites) 	<p>(Vaccinate all new foals)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FT vaccination • Rhino vaccination • Pregnant mares vaccinate 5, 7, 9 months of gestation with Rhino • Deworm
